Milestones

- Web presence: First blog posted July 2011, website created July 2012
- 13,000 cards collected by April 2014
- Bundles of Cheer program launched in December 2013
- Volunteer staff: 10 board members, over 250 volunteers, card making groups and sponsors

Cancer Statistics

- In the U.S., half of all men and one-third of all women will develop cancer
- Each year there are nearly 1.5 million new cases of cancer diagnosed

Recipients

• Any person with cancer at any stage of the disease process can qualify as a potential recipient, regardless of age, income or geographical restrictions

Card Makers

- Individuals and groups are encouraged to make cards on their own or organize card events
- Card makers have included religious groups, cancer survivors, youth groups, sororities, private card makers, retirement facilities, and senior day programs

Bundles of Cheer

- Individuals, groups and businesses are encouraged to donate travel-sized items to be included in practical care packages for men, women and children
- Donation items have included pillowcases, nail polish, lip balm, lotion, socks, toys, etc.

Ways to Help

- Making Cards: Many groups feel a sense of purpose and fulfillment
- Bundles of Cheer: Corporate sponsors receive recognition and are able to contribute products
- Donating Money: All funds donated go to identifying potential recipients, postage and supplies
- Donating Card Making Supplies: Supplies will be shared with card making groups
